We enroll 1,500 students from more than 60 communities.

Position Purpose:

Counselors are responsible for the day to day activities of one group of 10-20 campers. Behavior management, supervision, and counselor led activities are part of the fun of working at any of our EAGLES/EDGE programs! This position reports to the group's Senior Counselors.

Why Work at EAGLES/EDGE?

- Spend the summer (mostly) outdoors having fun.
- Build valuable transferable skills.
- Competitive, scaled, salary based on experience.

Essential Job Functions:

- Have fun with children and create lasting memories!
- Supervise daily activities of one group of campers- accurate attendance, regular headcounts, adherence to the schedule, and support during provided activities, and leadership during counselor-driven activities.
- When counselor-led activities are required, delivering engaging and entertaining program, including planning in advance and making good use of scheduled time
- Following the schedule in a timely fashion, including good communication when you will be late.
- Clear communication with leadership about camper behavior, staff issues, safety concerns, etc.
- Assist campers with all parts of their day- belongings management, led activities, restroom breaks, swim time, etc.
- Camp staff day is 8:30AM 4:15PM, with a 30 minute on campus break.
- Other duties as assigned.

Other Job Duties:

Attendance at staff training and staff meetings is mandatory. Some Counselors may have additional responsibilities if they are attached to Sports or Exploration Camps, which may include- curriculum planning, equipment or supply procurement, camp-specific meetings.

Qualifications:

The successful candidate should have at least one year of camp/youth program experience, more experience or college coursework helps define you as a Counselor versus a Junior Counselor. Camp counselors must be at least 16 years old as of June 5, 2023 Counselors must be able to work at least 7 of the ten camp weeks, and must attend all pre-camp orientation sessions.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

EAGLES/EDGE is set on a 175-acre rolling campus with two pools and seven fields. Candidates must be able to follow the camper schedule on foot each day, be able to lift up to 30 pounds, participate in games and activities, and maintain a healthy presence during the long outdoor camp day.
