

# St. John's Prep High School Grandfriends Day Frequently Asked Questions

## What is Grandfriends Day?

The Class of '22 will celebrate the 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Grandparents Day on Wednesday, October 16, 2019. Your son may invite their grandparent(s) or special friends to enjoy a special luncheon and short program, explore the campus, and visit the bookstore. The luncheon will take place in Memorial Gymnasium at 1:00 pm. Students have testing in the morning, and will greet their grandfriends once they arrive on campus. More details will be sent out to those who RSVP.

## What if my child does not have grandparents who are able to attend?

Students are welcome to invite a special friend if grandparents are unable to attend the event. October 16 is an early release day for the school; students who are not expecting guests will be dismissed for the day upon completion of their testing.
