Job Title: Senior Counselor – Activity Instructor

Activity Instructors sought:

Arts and Crafts: planning and teaching art explorations and projects with campers grades 1- 7. Campers visit 3-4 times during a week and spend 40 minutes in class.

Sports/Archery: planning and teaching sports, games and archery to all age groups across camp, grades 1-8. Campers visit 2-4 times a week for a 40 minute class.

Science/Nature: planning and teaching experiments and nature investigations with campers grades 1-7. Campers visit 3-4 times a week for a 40 minute class.

PreK/K Arts- Plan and implement daily 40 minute art explorations for prek/k groups of 15 in a summer camp setting.

PreK/K Musical Play- Plan and implement daily 40 minute lessons of music and/or movement activities for prek/k groups of 15 in a summer camp setting.

PreK/K Science- Plan and implement daily 40 minute science or nature explorations for prek/k groups of 15 in a summer camp setting.

Position Purpose:

Senior Activity Counselors are responsible for the delivery of an intentional, developmentally appropriate, innovative activity curriculum.

Essential Job Functions:

- Design and implement an activity curriculum for the whole summer, with consideration given to different age groups and theme weeks. Takes responsibility for ordering supplies needed, and management of said supplies.
- Works with group counselors to deliver program to counselors.
- Classroom management and strong interpersonal skills are required.
- Reports to the Camp Coordinator
- Activity counselors assist with all aspects of the camp day when not scheduled in their area-including but not limited to arrival and dismissal, weather protocols, special events, etc.
- Senior Counselors must have current certification in CPR and First Aid.
- Reports to the Assistant Camp Director.
- Camp staff day is 8:30am-4:15pm, with a ½ hour on campus break.

Other Job Duties:

Attendance at staff training and staff meetings is mandatory. Some Senior Counselors may have additional responsibilities if they are attached to sports or specialty camps, which may include- curriculum planning, equipment or supply procurement, camp-specific meetings, and other duties as assigned

Qualifications:

The successful candidate should have at least 3 years of camp/youth program experience, with at least one year of staff supervision experience. Preference for a Bachelor's degree in a related field, but college courses towards that degree would be considered. Senior counselors must be able to work at least 7 of the 8 camp weeks, as well as attending all of the pre-camp orientation sessions.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

Camp Christopher is set on a 175--acre rolling campus with 2 pools and seven fields. Candidates must be able to follow the camper schedule on foot each day, be able to lift up to 30 pounds, participate in games and activities, and maintain a healthy presence during the long outdoor camp day.
